for Cullen and Collins:

This popular duo recorded for Berliner in the late 1890's, including some interesting ragtime-influenced numbers. Joseph P. Cullen also made some solo discs for Berliner. Cullen and his partner William G. Collins advertised themselves as banjo instructors in Washington ca. 1895, but little else is known about them.

for Stone, Harry P.

Lived in Washington and was probably a member of the U. S. Marine Band. See also Chambers and Stone.
