# CURRENT BIBLIOGRAPHY

Compiled by Tim Brooks

This is a selective bibliography of recent articles dealing with recording history. Much important research appears in small, unfamiliar publications, and this department is intended to help locate it. Individual and institutional ARSC members are strongly encouraged to subscribe to and communicate with these publications. One of the goals of our organization is to foster research such as this, as well as communication between scattered researchers, and this can only be accomplished through the efforts of all of us.

Articles included here must be reasonably original, and concern recording history, as opposed to musicological, sociological or current collecting subjects (e.g., collector's news, LP reviews, current artists, etc.). This department supplements the Bibliography of Discographies in that non-discographical articles are included, such as biographies, articles on the recording industry, on phonographs, etc.; and it is sufficiently current so that most of the issues listed should still be available from the publishers. "W/D" indicates that the article is accompanied by a discography, although this is often no more than a simple list of issued recordings, by catalog number.

Issues covered are those received between October 1980 and July 1981.

Publications covered are principally those subscribed to by the compiler personally or by the Rodgers & Hammerstein Archives, New York Public Library. Since both of these agencies seem to be undergoing financial retrenchment, I would welcome any volunteer with access to a large number of periodicals to help compile the column in the future.
