CURRENT BIBLIOGRAPHY

Compiled by Tim Brooks

This is a selective bibliography of recent articles which deal with all phases of recording history. The department is intended to help locate the important research that often appears in small, unfamiliar publications. You, as an ARSC member, are urged to subscribe to or communicate with the publications within your area of interest. By individual involvement, we can further our goal of encouraging research and better communication between researchers.

To be included here, articles must be reasonably original and concern recording history, as opposed to musicological, sociological or current subjects. Current Bibliography supplements the Bibliography of Discographies in that non-discographical articles are included, and it is sufficiently current so that most of the issues listed should still be available from the publishers. "W/D" indicates that the article includes a discography, although this is often no more than a simple list of releases by catalog number.

Issues covered are those received between July and December 1981.

Current Notes

The rock research journal <u>Record Exchanger</u> has reappeared after two years with a fine issue (No. 29) featuring the Everly Brothers. Also back after a long hiatus is the English publication <u>Not Fade Away</u>; however, two other first-rate publications in the field, <u>Paul's Record</u> <u>Magazine</u> and <u>Time Barrier Express</u>, seem to have sunk without a trace.

<u>Goldmine</u>, having survived the untimely death of its young editor, Rick Whitesell, remains the pre-eminent publication in the field. It seems to have cornered most of the best researchers by the novel method of paying them for their pieces (modestly, to be sure). Jeff Tamarkin is the new editor of this monthly 200-page wonder.

Among 78-oriented publications, <u>Talking Machine Review</u> has issued a comprehensive 32-page discography by Brian Rust listing early Berliner, G&T and Zonophone recordings made in England as an insert to its Autumn, 1981 issue. <u>The Gunn Report</u>, another English publication, is once again included in Current Bibliography, due to the lucky circumstance of the New York Public Library obtaining a subscription (after the compiler stopped getting issues).

There may well be other small magazines currently publishing serious research on the history of recorded sound. Readers are encouraged to inform the compiler of any they see (which are not already covered here), care of the <u>ARSC Journal</u> editor. In this regard, I want to thank Lawrence Holdridge, Gerry Parker of the National Library of Canada, and David Ginzburg of Central Michigan University for contributions to the present listing.

^Publications themselves may also submit issues for indexing here (bearing in mind the type of article indexed, as explained above).
