The Journal follows <u>Webster's Third New International</u> <u>Dictionary of the English Language.</u> <u>Unabridged</u>, 3rd ed., for usage and spelling, and <u>The Chicago Manual of Style</u>, 13th ed., especially for capitalization, punctuation, and footnotes and bibliographies in the Humanities.

4. All material may be submitted either as typescript or in computer-readable form, though computer-readable form is preferable. Typescripts must be provided in duplicate (carbon or Xerox-type copies are acceptable) and should be double-spaced with numbered pages and at least one-inch margins on all sides. Notes should be numbered consecutively throughout the manuscript and typed on a separate page. Computer text files must be submitted on IBM PC-compatible diskettes--Microsoft Word or WordStar format or unformatted ASCII (with word-wrap, please!) are acceptable--accompanied by a print-out.
