RESEARCH MATERIALS NEEDED FOR A HISTORY OF THE PHONOGRAPH INDUSTRY

 - b) Surviving papers from the early days of Victor—everything seems to have been destroyed—but was it?

These are some of the needed areas. I possess a reasonably good documentation for a history but I am anxious to flesh out portions of the business history. My article in the recent ARSC Journal shows what can be recovered through careful and scholarly research
