UNESCO has established this annual day to promote international awareness of the significance of audiovisual documents and to draw attention to the need to safeguard them. Every year, activities are organized by different institutions around the world around a theme to drum up interest in the event. The theme for 2012 is: *Audiovisual heritage memory? the clock is ticking*. This year's World Day for AVH is being managed by the Coordinating Council of Audiovisual Archives Associations (CCAAA), of which ARSC is a member.
